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Chapter 1: Introduction

eMAM is integrated with Adobe InDesign CC, a desktop publishing software application used to create works such as posters, flyers, brochures, magazines, newspapers, presentations, books and eBooks. This will help you to use any of the assets in the eMAM library to make posters, flyers etc. and then share the finished material. The eMAM system manages content in local, remote, or cloud-based storage and archive systems for you to produce, store, share, deliver, and publish any kind of content. The export option allows you to synchronize the elements back to eMAM for project management, central asset management and archive. Using *Check-In* and *Check-Out* options, multiple users can work together on the same project/document without overwriting each other's changes.

The InDesign panel can track graphics elements used inside the InDesign documents and store them in one or more storage locations managed by eMAM. The *export* option in the panel makes the review, approval and final delivery processes seamless by automatically making PDF copies. Completed projects can be safely archived without affecting other documents. Default InDesign Extensions (.ind) is used for Adobe InDesign graphics document, however, (.indd) is used for Adobe InDesign document.

Purpose and Scope

The purpose of this document is to describe the installation of the eMAM InDesign Panel and explain the overview of its functions, features and the supported import and export workflows.

System requirements

Adobe recommends standard hardware and software requirements for Adobe InDesign. The only additional requirement for eMAM use would be an internet access to the eMAM library. The eMAM InDesign Panel is HTML5 based, so it is only supported in CC versions of the Adobe InDesign.

Installation

You can easily install and manage eMAM Panel for Adobe InDesign CC using **Command Line tool** or **App Manager**.

For installation steps of App Manager and eMAM panel for InDesign, please refer eMAM InDesign Installation Guide doc.

Note: The latest version of Adobe tools including Adobe InDesign uses Common Extensibility Platform (CEP) version 11. eMAM system must be upgraded to 5.2.18 to extend the support for CEP 11.

Chapter 2: Getting Started

This chapter explains how to launch and open eMAM InDesign Panel in the *Adobe InDesign CC*.

Open the eMAM InDesign Panel

Follow the steps below to open eMAM Panel in the Adobe InDesign:

1. Click on **Start** and to launch **Adobe InDesign CC (Run as administrator)** installed on your machine.




Figure 1: Launch Adobe InDesign by running as administrator

2. Open a new or an existing InDesign document.




Figure 2-Open New or existing InDesign document

3. From the Adobe InDesign top menu panel, go to **Windows>>Extensions>>eMAM** to open eMAM InDesign Panel.




Figure 3: Open InDesign Panel

4. Enter eMAM server details. Replace the default server details with your eMAM server name and click on **OK**.
For e.g.: <http://servername/>




Figure 4: eMAM server URL

- Now login to the eMAM InDesign Panel, using the eMAM login credentials provided by your eMAM unit administrator and click on *GO*.




Figure 5: eMAM InDesign Panel login

- Choose the unit you wish to login.




Figure 6: Choose Unit at login

- The eMAM Panel opens up in the Adobe InDesign as shown below. By default, *Documents* tab is displayed.




Figure 7: InDesign Panel window open in Adobe InDesign

Chapter 3: Overview of eMAM InDesign Panel

This chapter describes the overview of the eMAM InDesign Panel along with its various buttons, tabs, functions and features.

The InDesign Panel

Shown below is an overview of the eMAM Panel in the Adobe InDesign. Various tabs, functions and buttons are explained below in detail.

1. Documents tab

The *Documents* tab displays list of all the InDesign documents already exported back to eMAM and project collections. (*Projects are called documents in the InDesign application*). Note: Under this tab, only the InDesign docs and Collections are displayed unlike eMAM Premiere Panel and eMAM After Effects Panel where all projects (eMAM, Premiere, After Effects etc.) are displayed under the Projects tab.




Figure 9: Documents tab

2. Categories tab

The *Categories* tab displays list of all the categories in eMAM system that you can import to the Adobe InDesign.




Figure 10: Categories tab

3. Assets tab


The Assets tab displays all the assets managed by eMAM which can be imported to the Adobe InDesign. Assets are displayed with details like asset name, ingested on date, size and extension of assets. Archived assets are displayed with a red line underneath.

Options available under Assets tabs are:


- **Search filter:** Search filter displays list of all *Saved filters* from eMAM Director interface which can be used to search for assets in InDesign Panel.




- **Sort options:** You can sort assets displayed based on various criteria's like most recent, size, name, rating, description, category, ingested on and ingested by.



- **Order by** : Click on *Order by* to sort the assets in ascending or descending order.
- **Type of files**: Filter the assets based on asset type (*images, video, audio files and other files*). By default, all image files are displayed in the InDesign Panel.



- **Asset per page**: You can use this option to change the no. of assets (10, 50, 100, 150, 200, 250) displayed per page.



- **Page navigation** : This displays the current page no. and the next/previous buttons to navigate between the pages.

4. InDesign Document tab

This tab shows the name of the currently open InDesign document. The *export* button sends the final InDesign document back to the eMAM system as a PDF copy. Similar to the Premiere projects, along with the exported the InDesign doc, an .indd project file also gets exported to the eMAM system as an eMAM asset with UUID name. This eMAM asset gets displayed in the eMAM Director *Browse* widget but not under the eMAM panel *Documents* tab.





Figure 17: InDesign document tab

5. Search

You can use the *Basic Search* field for search operations under Documents, Categories and Assets Tab. Just enter the keywords in the field under any of the tabs. Based on your search feeds, suggestions get auto populated for selection.



Choose from the list of suggestions and click on the *Go* button. Results get displayed based on the search keywords.

Click on icon in the Basic search bar to clear the search results.

6. Import

You can use the *Import* button to import the InDesign documents under the *Documents* tab, import categories under the *Categories* tab and assets under the *Assets* tab from eMAM to the InDesign Panel.




Figure 13: Import of InDesign doc

7. Archive

Click on the *Archive* button to archive the selected assets under the *Documents*, *Categories* and *Assets* tab to the pre-set archive profiles. *Archive-Restore Status* window displays the status of the archived assets.




Figure 14: Archive status window

8. Restore

Likewise, click on the *Restore* button to restore the archived assets. *Archive-Restore Status* window displays the status of the restored assets.




Figure 15: Restore status window

9. Refresh

In a multi-user environment, users can simultaneously work on the same project. The *Refresh* button updates the extension Panel with the latest information in the eMAM.




Figure 16: Refresh icon

10. Settings

Using this *Setting* button, you can define where the *InDesign* document needs to be stored when it is exported to eMAM and also the ingest profile to be used for export. You can select from any of the ingest profiles from a drop-down list configured in the Super Admin console.




Figure 17: Settings window

- a. **Ingest Profile for export:** Select the ingest profile listed from the drop-down list (*pre-configured in the Super Admin console*) for export.
- b. **Local path for Document:** Browse and select the local path to save the exported InDesign document.
- c. **Local path for links:** Browse and select the local path for links to save the assets imported from eMAM. (*links are the files or objects in the document*)
- d. **Local path for Export:** Browse and choose a local path to temporarily store the exporting files before they get uploaded to eMAM servers.

S3 Upload Configuration: (for cloud workflows)

- e. **Upload part size:** Set the S3 upload part size. Default 5.
- f. **Upload queue size:** Set the S3 upload queue size. Default 5.

Click *Ok* to save the settings.



: Red icon indicates no connection to the mentioned UNC path



: Green icon indicates connection established with the mentioned UNC path

11. Check Out/Check In



Using this icon, you can *Check Out* any InDesign document. Other users can still access this document but can only save changes to this doc as a different version.



You can also Check-in an InDesign doc, so others can edit the current version. This symbol is only visible under Documents tab.

12. Lock



Using this icon, you can lock/unlock any InDesign doc. A locked InDesign doc cannot be imported or used by others. This symbol is only visible under Documents tab.

13. InDesign document



All InDesign documents are displayed with icon. A checked-out InDesign doc will be displayed as with the name of the user who checked out the project corresponding to it.

14. Asset under InDesign document

InDesign documents can have multiple assets under them along with a pdf copy of the asset.

15. Logout

Click on  icon to logout from your account.

16. Thumbnail view

Click on  icon to display items under Documents, Assets and Categories tab in thumbnail view.

17. List view

18. Asset Options window

Double click on any asset under the Assets tab or Categories tab, to open the Asset Options window. Asset Options window displays details of the asset such as the Title, its location status (online/nearline), thumbnail and various tabs to update metadata, review the history of the asset, review comments added to an asset, send approval requests, and File versions.




Figure 21: Asset Options window

- a. **Preview tab:** By default, Preview tab appears. You can preview any asset individually and view its properties like name, status etc.




Figure 22: Asset Options window- Preview tab

- b. Metadata tab:** You can see all the metadata details of the asset like Info, Embedded metadata, Custom metadata, and tags under different fields. You also have the option to edit and update metadata details of the asset as needed. Under Custom metadata, metadata values can be multi selected.




Figure 23: Asset Options window- Metadata tab

- **Info:** Displays details of the asset title (*editable field*), description (*editable field*), author (*editable field*), uploaded on, uploaded by, Metadata set (*editable field*), projects, categories. Editable fields can be updated using Update button.




Figure 24: Asset Options window- Metadata tab>Info tab

- **Embedded Metadata:** Embedded metadata is extracted by the system at ingest and is non-editable. These are technical and camera information about an asset, including file name, format, and size, bit rate, format information etc.

- **Custom Metadata:** Custom metadata fields are the custom metadata fields created by the users. You can make changes and update the changes using Update button.

- **Tags:** This tab displays keywords attached to the asset which can be used for searching the asset.

- c. **History tab:** History tab displays asset details and entire history of functions performed on the asset. It displays *Date of Actions, Action Performed, Username and id of the user who performed the action.*




Figure 28: Asset Options window- History tab

- d. Comments tab:** Comments tab allows you to view and add comments. Displays username, comment written by the user and date when the comment was written. Comments written on different interfaces (*assets, approval, eBIN*) are displayed here. You can also add comments by entering comments and clicking on the *Add Comment* button.




Figure 29: Asset Options window- Comments tab

- e. Approval:** Users may be required to send the asset for approval to another person, internal or external to the organization. An asset can be sent for approval to another eMAM user (internal approval) or externally as a link to someone who has no access to eMAM (external approval).

- o **Send to internal user:** Choose the name of the internal user from the drop-down list and click on Send for Approval button.




Figure 30: Asset Options window- Approval tab>Internal approval

- **Send to client for approval:** To send to the external client for approval, enter email address of the client, username, password and choose the expiry date for the link.




Figure 31: Asset Options window- Approval tab>External approval

- f. **File Versions:** File Versions displays the list of all the different versions created and available for the same asset. To import a particular version of an asset, set it as Face version before import.




Figure 32: Asset Options window- File Versions tab

Chapter 4: Import and Export Functions

1. Import

Import function can be used to import the assets from the eMAM system to the eMAM InDesign Panel. You can import the *InDesign documents* under the *Documents* tab or import categories under the *Categories* tab or import assets under the *Assets* tab from eMAM to the InDesign Panel.




Figure 33: Import of InDesign doc

Assets/Documents/Categories imported from eMAM will have below options during import:

- ✓ **Link:** Use *Link* option to directly link to the media in storage.
- ✓ **Localize:** Use *Localize* option to localize media to the local machine.




Figure 34: Import window for InDesign Projects

If there are multiple versions of the project, you need to first select the right version for import.




Figure 35: Import window for multiple project versions




Figure 37: Import window for assets




Figure 39: Import window for Category




Figure 41: Import error message window

2. Export

The export function can be used to export the InDesign projects and their contents from InDesign to the eMAM system. You can either export a new InDesign project to eMAM or import an existing InDesign project from eMAM, edit it, and then export it back to eMAM as a new version of that project.




Figure 42: Export button to export the project to eMAM

- a. **Export a new InDesign project to eMAM:** Any InDesign project created in the InDesign application can be exported to the eMAM system using eMAM panel. Just click on Export on the InDesign project and below export window is displayed.






Figure 43: Export new InDesign project to eMAM


- Project Collection: Choose a collection from the drop-down list to add this new project to any collection in the drop-down list.*




- Links: Select the elements listed to export to eMAM.*

- b. **Export the InDesign project imported from eMAM:** When a project is imported from eMAM to InDesign application, edited and then exported back to eMAM system, below export window appears:





Figure 44: Export window for a InDesign project imported from eMAM

Fill in details under all the tabs and click OK. The exported InDesign doc with assets will appear under the *Documents tab* as shown below. There will be an additional PDF document created for the InDesign doc with the same name as the InDesign doc. Note: Project Collections tab is not displayed in this scenario.

Note: Below error is displayed on export if there is an existing InDesign project with the same name.



During export, if project with same name already exists in eMAM, you will be asked to rename the project before export.

Chapter 4: Import and Export Workflow

1. Asset import and export workflow

To import assets from eMAM to InDesign Panel:

- Launch the **Adobe InDesign CC** application installed on your machine.
- Create a new document or open an existing document.
- From the Adobe InDesign top menu panel, go to **Windows>>Extensions>>eMAM** to open the eMAM Panel.
- Enter the eMAM server details.
- Now login to the eMAM Panel, using eMAM login credentials provided by your eMAM unit administrator and click on GO.
- Select the assets for import and click on the **Import** button. Under the *Asset Import options* window, you can either link assets to the media in storage or localize the files and click OK.




Figure 45: Select assets for import and click on the Import button

- Once all assets are imported to the InDesign Panel, assets will be available to be placed into the document. During import, the high res file is made into a symbolic link based on the settings under *local file path for links* in the *Settings* window and will relink the links in the InDesign docs to that symbolic link. Links can be images, pdf's or other files. You can also add assets from your local machine to the InDesign doc and make desired changes.




Figure 46: Add new files and make changes

- h. Once all the changes are made and saved in the InDesign document, go to the *InDesign document* tab and click on the **Export** button to export the finished doc back to eMAM as a pdf doc.




Figure 47: Click on the Export button to export the InDesign doc

During export, if project with same name already exists in eMAM, you will be asked to rename the project before export.




Figure 48: Duplicate project name warning message





Figure 49: Export window

- **Project Collection:** To assign this InDesign document a collection, choose from the list of collections displayed.



- **Links:** The *Links* tab displays the list of files that already exist in eMAM and also the new added files that can be exported to eMAM. Assets already existing in eMAM are highlighted under *Elements already exists in eMAM* and the newly added files are displayed with check boxes for selection. Select all the files that need to be exported back to eMAM.




Figure 53: Custom Metadata tab




Figure 55: Exported InDesign doc under Projects in eMAM Director interface

2. InDesign doc import and export workflow

1. Select the InDesign project for import and click on the *Import* button.
2. Project window displays all the versions of the selected project. Select the version for import to Adobe InDesign and click on *Ok*.




Figure 56: Import of InDesign doc (Choose a version)

3. Import options window opens up. By default, *Checkout* and *Localize* options are selected. Click OK.




Figure 57:Import options window

4. Progress of Localization of assets is displayed.




Figure 58:Localization progress

5. The selected InDesign doc gets checked out with below message.




Figure 59- Import of InDesign doc is checked out

6. After the InDesign doc is ready for export after editing, click on the *Export* button.




Figure 60: Option to export InDesign doc

7. Select details under Links, Categories, Tags and Custom Metadata tab. Click on *OK* to export the final doc back to eMAM.




Figure 61- In the Export window, select the files under Links tab, with other tabs

8. Export progress is displayed. You can monitor the dashboard for the ingest progress.




Figure 62: Export progress

3. Category import and export workflow

1. Select the category for import and click on the *Import* button.




Figure 64: Category import

2. All assets under the category and available to be placed in the document. Make desired changes and add new files if required in the InDesign document.
3. Now, go to the *InDesign doc* tab and click on the *Export* button. If a duplicate project name exists in eMAM, below message pops up to rename the project before export. Rename the InDesign doc and then click on the *Export* button.




Figure 65: Duplicate project exists warning message

4. Under the export window, select files for export (*includes existing files in eMAM and newly added files*). Similarly, fill in the Categories, Tags and Custom Metadata tabs and the click on the *OK*.




Figure 66: Export window- Links tab

- After a while, under the *Documents* tab of the eMAM InDesign Panel, you can view the exported InDesign doc with assets.




Figure 67: Exported InDesign project displayed under Documents tab




Figure 68: Exported InDesign doc displayed under Projects widget of Director interface
